

**V-245 Visit Prof. Colin Norman, J.Hopkins University**

Prof. dr. Colin Norman (Johns Hopkins University) spent part of his sabbatical visiting the Anton Pannekoek Institute for Astronomy at the University in Amsterdam sharing his time with the Observatory at the Leiden University. During his visit he closely interacted with several research groups in both Amsterdam and Leiden. In Leiden he primarily interacted and collaborated with Franx, Miley, Tielens, Linnartz, Kuijken and their groups. In Amsterdam he mainly interacted with Hessels, van Leeuwen, Ormel, Wijers, De Mink and their groups. In Leiden he gave a topical talk discussing Verlinde's alternate theory for gravity. His research focussed on emergent gravity, massive stripped stars, planetesimal formation and feedback processes in starforming regions with top heavy IMFs. It is expected that papers will eventually appear on these topics.
