

Report workshop “Starting the golden years: going strong after KiDS”

The workshop, to celebrate the scientific accomplishments of Konrad Kuijken in honour of his 60th birthday brought together almost 80 researchers, from early career to longstanding colleagues, all leaders in their field, from all of the world, with many different collaborations represented. The meeting took place in Leiden from April 8 to April 10. The scientific programme covered a wide range of topics: from galaxy dynamics, strong lensing, surveys, to cosmology with cosmic shear. Particularly exciting was that all the major ongoing and future weak lensing imaging surveys were represented. As such, this was a unique opportunity for informal discussion, as such a combination of speakers in a relatively small setting is rare. Hence, the participants were all very enthusiastic about the high level of the presentations and the breadth of the topics covered, a testament to the many research areas that Konrad has contributed to.
