

Scientific report 2025 ESLAB/EC meeting

The 2025 ESLAB symposium took place March 24-26 in Leiden. About 475 participants attended the meeting in person, while 150 joined online.

Most attendees also participated in the Euclid Consortium meeting that took partly place in parallel, and on March 26-28. The public ESLAB meeting

focused on the first scientific results from the first “quick” release. As highlighted by the program, a diverse range of scientific results were presented.

A particular highlight were the first results from a large sample of strong lenses that have been discovered, as well as early searches for distant AGN.

Also, a number of external speakers were invited to update the audience on some of the latest cosmological results. The results highlight the impact

that Euclid already has in extragalactic astronomy, as well as the prospects for cosmology.
